12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

of the external form or sensible appearance of things (or of persons); in particular, of space and its dimensions, -- as respects; mass and weight:

great; compass and extent: large, spacious; measure and height: long; stature and age: great, persons, eminent for ability, virtue, authority, power

WHITE: *leukos* {lyoo-kos'} ("light")
light, bright, brilliant; brilliant from whiteness, (dazzling) white:
