15 ¶ A fountain of gardens, a well of living waters, and streams from Lebanon.

### **SONG OF SOLOMON 4:16**

16 Awake, O north wind; and come, thou south; blow upon my garden, that the spices thereof may flow out. Let my beloved come into his garden, and eat his pleasant fruits.

### **SONG OF SOLOMON 5:1**

1 ¶ I am come into my garden, my sister, my spouse: I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have drunk my wine with my milk: eat, O friends; drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved.

### **SONG OF SOLOMON 6:4**

4 ¶ Thou art beautiful, O my love, as Tirzah, comely as Jerusalem, terrible as an army with banners.

**Tirzah means "delightful". Hence the flattering comparison.**

### **PSALM 48:2**

2 Beautiful for situation, the joy of the whole earth, is mount Zion, on the sides of the north, the city of the great King.

### **PSALM 48:3**

3 God is known in her palaces for a refuge.

### **PSALM 50:2**

2 Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God hath shined.

### **LAMENTATIONS 2:15**

15 All that pass by clap their hands at thee; they hiss and wag their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying, Is this the city that men call The perfection of beauty, The joy of the whole earth?

Pliny says, it was by far the most famous of any of the cities of the east; it was a city well built and compact together, beautiful for situation, very rich in Solomon's time, the place of divine worship, and was strongly fortified by nature and art:
