DEUTERONOMY 33:26

26 There is none like unto the God of Jeshurun, who rideth upon the heaven in thy help, and in his excellency on the sky.

DEUTERONOMY 33:27

27 The eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms: and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee; and shall say, Destroy them.

DEUTERONOMY 33:28

JESHURUN: HEBREW LEXICON -- STRONG'S NUMBER 3484

Yshuruwn {yesh-oo-roon'}

Jeshurun = "upright one", a symbolic name for Israel describing her ideal character

II SAMUEL 22:14

14 The LORD thundered from heaven, and the most High uttered his voice.

15 And he sent out arrows, and scattered them; lightning, and discomfited them.

PSALM 18:9

9 He bowed the heavens also, and came down: and darkness was under his feet.

10 And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.

PSALM 18:11

11 He made darkness his secret place; his pavilion round about him were dark waters and thick clouds of the skies.

PSALM 18:13

PSALM 18:14

PSALM 68:33

33 To him that rideth upon the heavens of heavens, which were of old; lo, he doth send out his voice, and that a mighty voice.

PSALM 68:34

34 Ascribe ye strength unto God: his excellency is over Israel, and his strength is in the clouds.

PSALM 104:1

1 Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty.

PSALM 104:2

2 Who coverest thyself with light as with a garment: who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain:

3 Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters: who maketh the clouds his chariot: who walketh upon the wings of the wind:

PSALM 144:5

5 Bow thy heavens, O LORD, and come down: touch the mountains, and they shall smoke.

PSALM 144:6

6 Cast forth lightning, and scatter them: shoot out thine arrows, and destroy them.

ISAIAH 19:1

1 The burden of Egypt. Behold, the LORD rideth upon a swift cloud, and shall come into Egypt: and the idols of Egypt shall be moved at his presence, and the heart of Egypt shall melt in the midst of it.

The word בָּדָד badad, signifies to live alone, and its signification is living separate.

GENESIS 1:3

SEPARATE: aphorizo {af-or-id'-zo}

Divide, sever, to mark off from others by boundaries, to limit, to separate, to appoint, set apart for some purpose

II CORINTHIANS 6:18

18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

46 This day will the LORD deliver thee into mine hand; and I will smite thee, and take thine head from thee; and I will give the carcasses of the host of the Philistines this day unto the fowls of the air,

and to the wild beasts of the earth; that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel.

NEHEMIAH 4:1

1 But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.

NEHEMIAH 4:2

2 And he spake before his brethren and the army of Samaria, and said, What do these feeble Jews? will they fortify themselves? will they sacrifice? will they make an end in a day? will they

revive the stones out of the heaps of the rubbish which are burned?

NEHEMIAH 4:3
