CREATED: {ktid'-zo}

to make habitable, to people, a place, region, island; hence to found a city, colony, state; to create: of God creating the worlds; to form, shape, i.e. to completely change or transform

EPHESIANS 2:11

11 ¶ Wherefore remember, that ye being **in time past** Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands;

EPHESIANS 2:12

12 That at that time **ye were without Christ**, being **aliens** from the commonwealth of Israel, and **strangers** from the covenants of promise, **having no hope**, and **without God in the world**:

EPHESIANS 2:13

13 **But now** in Christ Jesus ye who **sometimes were far off** are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

EPHESIANS 2:14

14 ¶ For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;

EPHESIANS 2:15

ACCESS: {pros-ag-ogue-ay'}

the act of bringing to, approach to God, i.e. that relationship with God whereby we are acceptable to him and have assurance that he is favourably disposed towards him

EPHESIANS 2:19

19 Now therefore ye are no more **STRANGERS* and **FOREIGNERS*, but **FELLOWCITIZENS* with the saints, and of the household of God;

STRANGERS: xenos {xen'-os}

alien (from a person or a thing); without the knowledge of, without a share in; new, unheard of, one who receives and entertains another hospitably, with whom he stays or lodges, a host

FOREIGNERS: paroikos {par'-oy-kos}

one who lives in a place without the right of citizenship; metaph. without citizenship in God's kingdom; one who lives on earth as a stranger, a sojourner on the earth; of Christians whose fatherland is in Heaven

FELLOWCITIZENS: sumpolites {soom-pol-ee'-tace} possessing the same citizenship with others, a fellow citizen: of Gentiles as received into communion of the saints, i.e. of the people consecrated to God

EPHESIANS 2:20

20 And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;

EPHESIANS 2:21

21 In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord:

EPHESIANS 2:22

22 In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.

EPHESIANS 3:1

1 ¶ For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles,

EPHESIANS 3:2

2 If ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward:

EPHESIANS 3:3

3 How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,

EPHESIANS 3:4

4 Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ

EPHESIANS 3:5

5 Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;

EPHESIANS 3:6

6 **That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs**, and of the same body, and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel:

EPHESIANS 3:7

7 Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power.
