II PETER 1:2

2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,

II PETER 1:3

3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath **called us to glory and virtue**:

II PETER 1:4

4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these **YE MIGHT BE PARTAKERS OF THE DIVINE NATURE**, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

BLAMELESS: (amemptoi) means "above reproach." This does not mean sinless perfection.

unmixed, pure as in wines or metals, without a mixture of evil,

HORNLESS, or sincere, without mixture of deceit or guile,

PROVERBS 3:29

29 **Devise not evil** against thy neighbour, seeing he dwelleth securely by thee.

PROVERBS 14:22

22 ¶ Do they not err that **devise evil**? but mercy and truth shall be to them that **devise good**.

MATTHEW 10:16

16 ¶ Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

Giezerichus, an Arian, king of Vandals, is said to have exceeded all that went afore him in cruelty towards the orthodox side, of both sexes. In that Laniena Parisiensis 30,000 Protestants were basely butchered in one month, 300,000 in one year.
